

Oregon Lifeline (Oregon Telephone Assistance Program)



The Oregon Public Utility Commission (PUC) manages the Oregon Lifeline program. If you qualify, this federal and state government assistance program reduces your monthly residential/landline or wireless phone bill by \$12.75.

Income limits: Total household income is at or below 135% of federal poverty guidelines

The following figures are based on the 2016 Health & Human Services (HHS) poverty guidelines published in the *Federal Register* on January 25, 2016. This is an independent calculation of 135% of the 2016 federal poverty guidelines. Refer to the PUC for exact calculation.
