

OSECE 2021 Statewide Conference

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can I register for the whole conference once or do I have to register for each day separately?

You may register once and then attend each separate day that you wish to attend.

2. How do I request CEUs or CRCs?

Zoom tracks how long you participate in the webinar and this information is used to verify attendance for CEUs and CRCs. Credits will not be given per session but rather per day, so a full day will need to be attended to receive credit. After attending the conference, click **HERE** for a link to the CEU/CRC evaluation form. Once this is completed and submitted to OSECE staff, your attendance will be verified and you should receive your certificate within a few weeks.

3. Our team is going to watch the conference together in a big conference room but we are concerned about getting CEU's if we are not individually logged in. What should we do about this?

Please have staff log in either on their cell phones or their laptops and then mute it on those devices to watch together in one room. Otherwise, each person would not be eligible for CEUs.

4. Will there be closed captioning available?

Yes, there will be closed captioning available for each session.

5. Will we still receive swag for the conference?

Yes, swag for the conference will be mailed to your agency address. Please connect with your agency to pick up your swag.

6. Will the sessions be recorded so that I can view them later if I am unable to attend? Can I get CEUs or CRCs for watching them at a later date?

Some sessions may be recorded with presenter permission but CEUs and CRCs will only be offered during the conference.

7. Is there a cost to attend the conference? Who can attend?

The conference is free to agencies in Oregon providing IPS services, OSECE board members, and to employees of Oregon Vocational Rehabilitation. If a person is unaffiliated with any of the

aforementioned, you may email an OSECE staff member to request permission to attend. However, there are limits on this due to the conference funding being provided by the Oregon Health Authority.

8. Will food be served at the conference?

Yes. You may serve yourself food during the conference if you have any in your refrigerator. ;)
